Getting Started with MapServer

The participants will go through the process of setting up a MapServer environment which includes configuring a Web server and creating a MapServer application. Once a map file is created, the participants will then go through the process of creating a web-based interface. Important MapServer and Web mapping concepts will be discussed throughout the workshop. A significant portion of the workshop will involve accessing data from several different data types and incorporating them into a MapServer map file.
